

COVID-19 trajectory for Haiti

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
Aim of this briefing. We present the number of confirmed cases and deaths ¹ from COVID-19 infection in Haiti since the start of the outbreak, which we measure as the number of days since the first confirmed case. We report whether the case rate (per 100,000 people) is currently increasing or decreasing, and describe the current Haiti case load compared to the Haiti outbreak peak. 
