### Weekly Summary for the week ending Thu 20 Apr 2023.

In the week to Thu 20 Apr 2023 among the 20 CARICOM members and associate members:

- There have been 910 new confirmed cases (compared to 43 last week, and 822 two weeks ago)
- There have been 27 new confirmed deaths (compared to 0 last week, and 8 two weeks ago).
- In the past 24 hours there have been 4 new confirmed cases and 0 new confirmed deaths.
